Entry Requirements:

Candidates are required to have an undergraduate degree or equivalent, a minimum of two years language teaching experience and a minimum B2 level of English. If you have successfully completed a Cambridge DELTA, Trinity DipTESOL or a PGCE (UK) you would be eligible to apply for exemption from the core module.

Tuition Fees (Online modules)

Core Module (Language Teaching Methodology): £2,420
 Elective Modules (x2): £1,210 each

The modules:

The MAPDLE is a 180-credit award (worth 90 points in the European Credit Transfer System).

The Core Module, Language Teaching Methodology (MALTM), is worth 60 credits.

The Elective Modules are worth 30 credits each. Two electives will need to be chosen from the list above. The Dissertation (15,000 words) is supervised at distance and applies the knowledge and skills acquired on the previous modules. It is an obligatory module for completion of the MA and is worth 60 credits.
