Entry Requirements:

Candidates should have a UK honours degree or equivalent, language teaching experience, and also a level of proficiency in English sufficient for successful completion of a course of study at postgraduate level. Access to current language learners for classroom investigation is necessary for candidates who take the core MALTM module, and for some electives (MADLA, MATYL, MATALL, MACLIL). Access to current language learners is useful but not required for the Dissertation and for the other electives (MAMAT, MATEA, MAMILE, MATEAP, MATD).

Tuition Fees

Core Module (Language Teaching Methodology): £2,420
Elective Modules (x2): £1,210 each

The modules:

The MAPDLE is a 180-credit award (worth 90 points in the European Credit Transfer System).

The Core Module, Language Teaching Methodology (MALTM), is worth 60 credits (30 ECTS).

The Elective Modules are worth 30 credits (15 ECTS) each. Two electives will need to be chosen from the list above. The Dissertation (15,000 words) is supervised at distance and applies the knowledge and skills acquired on the previous modules. It is an obligatory module for completion of the MA and is worth 60 credits (30 ECTS).
