This is a highly practical course that takes you through all the key stages in developing professional-looking educational videos. The course extends over 6 weeks and includes:

Schedule

This course consists of 6 units. Each unit requires approximately 5-7 hours work per week, including webinars, answering forum questions and doing the weekly task. Live sessions are normally held on a Sunday, and recorded for those who cannot attend.

Webinar Session:	What you will learn:	Task for that week:
Module 1 Webinar 'Getting Started'	Takes you through what Movavi can do and gets you started with your first screen captures	Produce your first screen capture video using Movavi and then edit it and add an intro and an outro to the video.
Module 2 Webinar 'Movavi Assets'	Building your video, adding assets to give it a professional look	Produce a screen capture video with additional assets to make the video more engaging. This includes arrows, text audio and additional assets provided by Movavi.
Module 3 Webinar 'Combining Resources'	Adding your webcam, green screen and external assets	Produce a video that combines screen capture video with video that you have brought in from your own camera or smartphone. Include a green screen introduction to the video.
Module 4 Webinar 'Making it Professional'	Diving deeper into what Movavi can offer (final coursework set, to be completed in week 6)	Produce a video that includes music and combines a whole range of video assets and visual assets.
Module 5 Webinar 'Video on YouTube'	Distributing your video, compression and running a YouTube channel	Produce a professional video that is then added onto your YouTube channel.
Module 6 (no webinar) Bringing it all together	Participants have the complete week to do the final coursework (set in week 4)	Course work handed in at the end of the week.

Requirements and Resources

- Participants need a computer, a headset (with microphone) and an Internet connection and a Gmail acccount. You can do much of the course on a tablet or mobile device, but will need a computer for certain activities.
- Mac users are welcome but please be aware there might be differences as the training material has been created using a PC.
- All participants have access to NILE's extensive ELT e-Library and the NILE digital learning platform during the course and for
 a further two months, to access materials and keep in touch with your new colleagues. We also encourage you to sign up to
