### Fees include:

- 25 hours per week tuition (including, in July and August, cross-curricular workshops and cultural exchanges)
- carefully selected homestay accommodation on a half-board basis; or residential accommodation (self-catering or half-board), available at the University of East Anglia in July and August
- materials, including course file, handouts, city map, information on Norwich
- end-of course certification
- use of specialist ELT library and online resource centre

### Accommodation in Norwich

- Homestay accommodation is provided in single study-bedrooms with carefully selected hosts. It comprises bed, breakfast & evening meal each day and light lunch (or packed lunch as appropriate) at weekends.
- Residential accommodation is provided on the campus of the University of East Anglia in single en-suite study-bedrooms, in university 'houses' or 'flats' with a shared kitchen/dining room equipped for self-catering and, if in half-board accommodation, includes two meals a day.
