

Delta Application Tasks

Delta Module 1

Task 1

You will be given a short text written by a lower intermediate learner in response to the following task: Write about the advantages and disadvantages of using laptops.

You will need to identify three key strengths and three key weaknesses of the text. Provide an example of each strength and each weakness.

Your answer should focus on some or all of the areas listed below:

- Task achievement
- Appropriacy of genre and style
- Organisation
- Cohesion
- Punctuation

Task 2

You will be given a speaking activity for pre-intermediate level learners, and you will need to identify a total of three key speaking subskills / features of discourse that learners at this level would need in order to complete the activity successfully. You will also have to provide an example specific to this activity to support each choice.

Delta Module 2

In Module 2, in addition to writing background essays, candidates are required to plan and deliver lessons, and reflect on their teaching of those lessons.

Task 1 (500 words)

You will be asked to describe a lesson which you have recently taught, outlining

- a) your intentions in terms of learning outcomes prior to the lesson
- b) how the lesson went
- c) what you learnt from the lesson

You will not need to include a lesson plan.

Task 2 (500 words)

You will be asked to produce a text in which you will have to include an outline of the general beliefs and principles that guide you as a teacher, reflect on how these beliefs and principles inform your teaching, identify your strengths and weaknesses as a teacher, and what effect they have on your learners.

Delta Module 3

Task 1

You will need to choose the specialism you would like to work with for the purpose of Module 3 and explain why you'd like to work with this specialism (don't worry if you can't choose the specialism now, you can indicate several specialisms, and we will narrow those down during the interview).

Task 2 (around 750 words)

You will need to write up a profile of the group you are intending to use for DELTA Module 3, and the areas you would choose for the 20-hour course you will be designing for this group.
